Currently, I am looking for a longer-term opportunity. Here is more information about my business and my current ideas.

'Charlie's Mini Golf is a 9-hole mini golf course with captivating obstacles, including a moving windmill, a castle with a drawbridge, a bridge, a lighthouse, and a loop. The entire setup is 147 feet of course but has a compact size of 12m square, it all packs up conveniently into a vintage horse box trailer that transforms into a 'clubhouse.' All components operate on battery power, eliminating the need for external electricity or water sources.

I have previously operated in Folkestone, and my mini golf course proved to be a valuable addition to the local community. It not only attracted visitors to the Harbour Arm but also generated increased foot traffic for nearby retailers.

I am seeking the opportunity to operate Charlie's Mini Golf during school holidays and weekends. I wish to maintain an affordable pricing model at £3 per person per game, I aim to offer an accessible and enjoyable activity for individuals and families alike.

Ideally, I envision setting up Charlie's Mini Golf in Kine Croft, there is a small gravel section towards the Cross Keys, however, I am open to exploring other options, such as Bull Croft Park.

I believe that my Mini Golf can contribute positively to the chosen location, offering a unique and enjoyable experience for residents and visitors. Mini Golf has had a big revival since 2020 with lots of towns now having this offering, for example, Henley and Newbury have built one in the last few years.

I've included some more photos of past set-ups, I'm happy to have a phone call or meeting, if it's easier to chat it through or if you need more infomation. Let me know.


