AGATHA CHRISTIE BENCH AND PLINTH

Recommendation:

That the Town Council enters into an arrangement with the Women's Institute (WI) in which the WI help with the maintenance of the Agatha Christie bench and plinth

1. Purpose

This proposal seeks Full Council approval to recommend that the Women's Institute (WI) assist in the maintenance of the Agatha Christie bench and plinth in Wallingford. Specifically, this would include the regular waxing, cleaning, and general care required to preserve these important town landmarks.

2. Background
